






PARKING AND TURNING PROBLEMS

Following contact with Teign Housing, who own the Sandfords Estate opposite the school, it has become apparent that the road beyond the school (see map below) is a private road, and even turning is prohibited. This creates a real difficulty for our parents and carers, as those of you who have to drive your child to school are now expected to either turn around opposite the school gates, creating a hazard for children and adults crossing the road, or to park along the main street, where there is limited parking and a real lack of pavements to walk your children to school. We really appreciate the predicament that this will put many of you in. We are in discussions with Devon Highways about possible solutions. While a more permanent solution is found, please use a 'safety first' common sense approach to dropping off your children to school.



LOOK OUT FOR NASTY RASHES

We have been informed that there is a high prevalence of scabies in the local area. If your child has a dry, pimply and red rash, please take them to the doctors or pharmacist to check for scabies. This is a nasty condition that is very infectious but easily treated with cream.


